### **Recognition and Initial Management of Fulminant Myocarditis**

early cardiogenic shock secondary to myocarditis is challenging during the early stages of workup and treatment A high index of suspicion is warranted Initial management Avoid treatment of sinus tachycardia with rate control agents (especially those with negative inotropic properties such metoprolol, diltiazem, or verapamil)

CHQ-GDL-60010 - Sepsis - Recognition and emergency management in children - 2 - Septic shock is a subset of sepsis in which profound circulatory, cellular, and metabolic abnormalities are associated with a greater risk of mortality<sup>14</sup> It is identified by sepsis and cardiovascular organ dysfunction, acknowledging that hypotension is a late sign in children<sup>10</sup>
